"Harassment, intimidation, or bullying means: any intentional written, verbal, graphic, or physical act that a student or group of students exhibits toward another particular student(s) more than once and the behavior both causes mental or physical harm to the other student(s) and is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student(s); or - violence within a dating relationship."

This report fulfills our requirement to semiannually provide the Board of Education president a written summary of all reported incidents of harassment. (ORC3319.321)
