Dear Wayne County Schools Career Center Families,

Today we received notification of a positive COVID-19 case. While we must protect the privacy of our staff and students we feel it is important to communicate transparently with you.

We are working directly with the Medina County Health Department to address the situation. Please remember that a confirmed case in the building does not mean your child was exposed to COVID 19. Through contract tracing the Health Department will notify parents/guardians/staff members of anyone exposed to the positive case. This notification will include specific instructions. Based on our initial conversation with the MCHD, at this time, no students or staff members are required to quarantine.

To protect the confidentiality of our students and staff the Wayne County School Career Center is not allowed to give out any personal information related to this matter.

The safety of our students and staff are most important to us and we will continue to be in close contact with the Medina County Health Department in this matter.

We will continue to follow the appropriate COVID-related recommendations and guidelines and the appropriate steps under the current circumstances for cleaning and disinfecting have/will be taken. We will continue to follow all school guidelines and protocols as outlined for re-entering this school year.

We are still encouraging the following recommended guidelines.

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- Use alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available
- Wear a mask
- Avoid close contact with those who are sick
- Avoid touching your eyes, mouth and nose.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue or by using your sleeve

• Conduct a daily health/symptom self-evaluation, stay home if you are sick and contact our school nurse/COVID 19 coordinator Tracy Hackworth at 330-669-7011 if you or someone in your household is ill.
