

# College Credit Info

Dear Parent,

Your child's academic success is important to us at The Wayne County Schools Career Center. We would like to make you aware of alternative academic opportunities of College Credit Plus classes offered at our school through Stark State College. We offer College Credit Plus academic course and trade courses giving students the opportunity to earn both college and high school credit for the same coursework in the high school setting. This is an excellent opportunity to earn tuition free college credit as a high school student. If your child currently has the ability and interest in completing college coursework while in high school, we invite you to consider the information below.

In order to enroll in College Credit plus your child must take the ACT, SAT or ACCUPLACER test and score as follows:

**College Composition I and II** - ACT Writing 18 or ACCUPLACER Writeplacer 5

**Political Science (Government)** – Must have a score in one subject area of the ACT, SAT or ACCUPLACER

**Student Success Seminar**- Must have a score in one subject area of ACT or ACCUPLACER

**Computer Applications for the Professional**- Must have a score in one subject area of ACT or ACCUPLACER and a 21 on a computer test administered at the Career Center

**Business Entrepreneurship courses**- ACT 18 reading or Next Gen ACCUPLACER Reading 244; Conditional scores with a 3.0 GPA are ACT 16 reading or Next Gen ACCUPLACER Reading 232

**Agribusiness and Production courses**- ACT English 18, Math 22, ACCUPLACER Writeplacer 5, Next Gen ACCUPLACER Math 263, Reading 263; Conditional scores with a 3.0 GPA are ACT or ACCUPLACER Writeplacer 4 or Next Gen ACCUPLACER Math 259, Reading 256

**Criminal Justice Courses**- Must have a score in one subject area of the ACT, SAT or ACCUPLACER

All requirements must be met by May 1, 2019 in order to be enrolled.

The ACT will be given to all juniors in February or March free of charge at their home high school. Students can additionally register to take the ACT on their own at a different time. See [www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org) for ACT registration and test dates.

The ACCUPLACER test is offered at the Career Center. Contact your school counselor if interested in testing.
