Welcome to Adult & Community Education

We thought it would be helpful for you to have a few details about the school to make the most of your experience as a student here:

## **FOOD**

The Adult Commons is open from 8:00 AM to 8:30 PM in the Adult Forcation Center. A beverage machine, refrigerator and microwave are available for your convenience.

The Snack Shack is housed in the Main Commons and is open 3:00-8:00 pm Monday through Thursday. You can purchase snacks, meal items, and beverages with cash only. The Snack Shack is open during the day as well—if it is not staffed when you would like to make a purchase please find Pam the Casheria Manager; she will be able to assist you.

**The Cafeteria** is located at the top of F-Wing or front and center of the main building. The school cafeteria serves lunches daily when the High School students are in session. Adults may purchase a lunch. Lunches are served from 10:40-12:30. The main Commons will be available after 2:45 for adult students to access microwaves. You may utilize the main Commons for lunch or breaks however masks must be worn unless eating or drinking.

#### **REST ROOMS**

Check the building map located in each room by the exit for rest room locations nearest your classroom.

#### **PARKING**

Student parking is available behind the Adult Education Building, behind B wing, and in front of the school in the main circle lot.

#### SAFFTY

Badges should be worn at all times in the building. If you have lost or misplaced your badge please notify the Adult Education Office immediately.

As a school, we are required to perform specific drills throughout the year. You may experience a Fire Drill, Tornado Drill, or Lock Down Drill throughout your training. Everyone in the building is required to participate. Your instructor will guide you through the drill.

### **COVID SAFETY PROCEDURES**

- Temperatures taken before leaving home and may be required at school
- Students stay home with 100°+ temperature and/or other symptoms
- Face coverings for all staff and students (fabric covering mouth and nose, school appropriate)
- Hand washing at minimum of beginning and end of lab
- Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes throughout Career Center
- Classrooms and labs and all other common areas social distancing
- Outside breaks social distancing
- Seating charts in all classes
- Lunches/breaks in the commons practice social distancing

- Cleaning crew sanitize restrooms/classrooms/labs/common areas between HS and Adult classes (deep cleaning after school)
- Directional arrows in hallway for traffic flow
