Policies

The WCSCC Preschool does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex or handicap. Children enrolled in the morning class must be three years of age by September 30th. Children enrolled in the afternoon class must be four years of age by September 30th. Children should be able to take care of their toileting needs with minimal assistance. Enrollment will be limited to eighteen children in the morning and twenty children in the afternoon class. Priority for the four-year-old class will be given to children enrolled in the morning class the previous year. Parents will be notified in the late spring or early summer as to the status of their child's enrollment.

The Wayne County Schools Career Center Child Development Center hosts two preschool programs. A program designed to meet the developmental needs of children three years old is held in the morning. A program for four-and-five year olds is held in the afternoon.

Classroom days and times will be determined each school year according to the schedules of the high school students who work in the laboratory setting.

Each classroom is under the direction of a certified instructor. Under the guidance of their instructor, high school students develop a curriculum to meet the physical, intellectual, social and emotional needs of each child enrolled. Children will participate in art, music, language, science, math, large motor and creative movement activities planned by the high school students
